## SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME A Scriptural Reflection

### Reflecting on God's Word

To be a disciple of Jesus Christ means to learn from him. He is the teacher, we the students; he is the master, we his servants. But what is it we are to learn? One important title for Jesus is the Lamb of God who has come to serve by taking away our sin. He serves by leading us to participate in the holiness of God. We are to do the same for others.

Jesus came to understand his own calling by reading and praying the book of the prophet Isaiah, especially the four poems found there called the Servant Songs. Today we hear part of the second song in which the servant professes how he was formed as servant from the womb, not only to bring back Israel to God, but to be a light to the nations, so God's "salvation may reach to the ends of the earth" (Isaiah 49:6).

Those who serve Jesus as disciples are to join in this work of bringing God's salvation to the world. Paul recognizes this in his greeting to the Corinthians, noting his call to be an apostle of Christ, one sent by God to the church at Corinth, which has been made holy in Christ and called to be holy. Paul is sent not only to them, but to "all those everywhere who call on the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Corinthians 1:2).

God's will is our holiness. By responding to the call to know Jesus as the Lamb of God, we accept the invitation to participate in this holiness and become the vehicle for inviting others to dwell there.

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to once again thank all those who assisted with the decorating and un-decorating of the Church. You helped to make our Advent and Christmas liturgies sparkle. Speaking of sparkling, I wanted to let you know that last week we had a number of carpets cleaned in the conference room and the rectory offices. I am sure you will notice the difference in the conference room.

Speaking of repairs...the heavy rains over the last month have continued to reveal to us several places where our church roof has been leaking and causing underlying damage to our church. Anyone who has ever had a roof leak knows how difficult it is to trace the source of the water. I am grateful to Jim Morrison and those he has contracted with to assist us in repairing the immediate damage and assessing the long term repair needs.

We have also begun the process of addressing our long term need for a better sound system for the Church. The first step will be to have a sound engineers determine the pattern of our current sound problems and develop computer models which will seek to address the areas of need. We are currently in the process of taking bids for the first phase. I will keep you informed as we move forward.

Next Sunday (January 22<sup>nd</sup>) marks the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision *Roe vs. Wade*. In light of this tragic anniversary I would like to share with you a brief passage from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops Office for Pro-Life. "When we hear a phrase all our lives, it can become stale. No matter how true or profound, it loses the power to capture our attention and invite reflection. *Made in the image of God* is such a phrase. Because God created human beings in His own image, each of us has a unique dignity. "Of all visible creatures only man is 'able to know and love his creator'...and he alone is called to share by knowledge and love, in God's own life. It was for this end that he was created, and this is the fundamental reason for his dignity" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 356). *What does it mean to be made in the image of God?* Jesus himself is the answer. It means to be holy and loving, to give oneself for the sake of others even to the point of death, so we might share eternally in God's life, our souls united again with our risen bodies (*Catechism*, 459, 460). Even in this life our soul – which is our innermost self – is a single unity with our body (*Catechism*, 365). This oneness of body and soul calls us to treat our bodily life, and that of others, with the greatest respect. And the relationship God has established with and among us calls us to reach out to every human being with unconditional love. Jesus taught that we must love one another as He loves us (*Jn. 15:12*). And the fact that every human is made in God's image has specific implications depending on one's situation in life."
