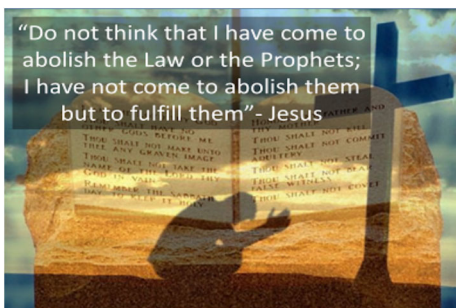

## SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME A Scriptural Reflection

### Reflecting on God's Word

We live in a country where we prize our freedom, cling to our right to choose, and even define our homeland as "the land of the free." Today's scriptures remind us that along with rights come responsibilities. We are to respond to our God who made us and calls us to be a people of the new covenant, ratified by the saving death of God's Son on the cross.

"If you choose you can keep the commandments, they will save you," says Ben Sira (Sirach 15:15). For the Jewish people the law was a blessing and those who chose to keep the law would be blessed with life. That choice is still before us today.

Jesus' teachings reveal his wisdom in understanding the law of the Mosaic covenant. His grasp of what was at the heart of the law can be clearly found in the long form of today's Gospel. While there is an option for a shorter version, spend some time with the longer reading (Matthew 5:17-37).

We are to live as kin in what has been called the "kin-dom" of God. In a world that justifies preventative strikes, Jesus forbids not only killing but even getting angry and bearing a grudge. He teaches that reconciliation takes priority over worship, that the prohibition against adultery extends even to looking with lust at another, reducing a person to an object for self-gratification. Finally, he asks us not to swear but to speak with simplicity and integrity.

Some might dismiss all this as impossible to achieve. But, as a young virgin was once told: "[N]othing will be impossible for God" (Luke 1:37).

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the Church celebrates "World Marriage Sunday" focusing in particular on the vocation of married life. Therefore I offer for your reflection a brief passage from Pope John Paul II 1981 encyclical *Familiaris Consortio* when he wrote: The gift of Jesus Christ is not exhausted in the actual celebration of the sacrament of marriage, but rather accompanies the married couple throughout their lives. This fact is explicitly recalled by the Second Vatican Council when it says that Jesus Christ "abides with them so that, just as He loved the Church and handed Himself over on her behalf, the spouses may love each other with perpetual fidelity through mutual self-bestowal.... For this reason, Christian spouses have a special sacrament by which they are fortified and receive a kind of consecration in the duties and dignity of their state. By virtue of this sacrament, as spouses fulfill their conjugal and family obligations, they are penetrated with the Spirit of Christ, who fills their whole lives with faith, hope and charity. Thus they increasingly advance towards their own perfection, as well as towards their mutual sanctification, and hence contribute jointly to the glory of God... Christian marriage, like the other sacraments, "whose purpose is to sanctify people, to build up the body of Christ, and finally, to give worship to God," is in itself a liturgical action glorifying God in Jesus Christ and in the Church. By celebrating it, Christian spouses profess their gratitude to God for the sublime gift bestowed on them of being able to live in their married and family lives the very love of God for people and that of the Lord Jesus for the Church, His bride. Just as husbands and wives receive from the sacrament the gift and responsibility of translating into daily living the sanctification bestowed on them, so the same sacrament confers on them the grace and moral obligation of transforming their whole lives into a "spiritual sacrifice." What the Council says of the laity applies also to Christian spouses and parents, especially with regard to the earthly and temporal realities that characterize their lives: "As worshippers leading holy lives in every place, the laity consecrate the world itself to God."



Next weekend our parish will once again be invited to participate in the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). The Annual Catholic Appeal seeks to raise the \$3.5 million dollars needed to support the many educational, spiritual and charitable works of the Diocese of San Diego. Our response to the Annual Catholic Appeal is an opportunity to accomplish the mission of Christ not only in our parish, but also in a way that shows that we are all part of one diocesan church.

This year our parish goal is \$57,000, which will go toward two primary objectives. First, it will allow us to fulfill our commitment to the Diocese of San Diego. Secondly, as in past years, any monies received beyond our assessment will return directly to our parish and enable us to continue the many programs that assist us in our ongoing spiritual renewal and communion to which we are called as followers of Christ. All registered members of the parish will receive in the mail a brief letter from me introducing the Annual Catholic Appeal along with a brochure outlining how the monies raised are used in the service of the Church in San Diego and our parish in particular. I would ask that you please fill out the pledge envelope and return it to us as soon as possible. If you do not receive the letter and brochure or if you are not yet a registered member of the parish you may pick up a pledge envelope and brochure next weekend at the main entrance of the church.

## STEWARDSHIP

### No Money, No Mission

Occasionally Catholics ask, "Why is the Church always talking about money?" In the United States, the Church manages itself without government interference or support, so all the money for Church ministries must come from us. We are called to support the Church financially in three ways. The first is the weekly parish offertory, which is used for all parish expenses. Our money in the collection ensures that we can serve and be served as Christ calls us. The second way is through contributions to our diocese to fund ministries and programs too complicated for any single parish to provide, such as training clergy, educational and social services, and marriage and family ministries. The third way is in special or second collections benefitting worthy causes in our parish, diocese, or beyond. We choose which of these to support and in what amount. As the Body of Christ, we can only fulfill our mission if there is money to pay the way. Let's all do our part, for the love of God.

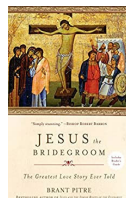

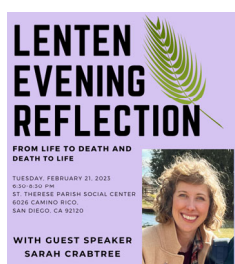
