But he, desiring to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbor? Jesus made answer and said, "A man fell victim to robbers as he went down from Jerusalem to Jericho. They stripped and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead. A priest happened to be going down that road, but when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side. Likewise a Levite came to the place, and when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side. But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him was moved with compassion at the sight. He approached the victim, poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them. Then he lifted him up on his own animal, took him to an inn and cared for him. The next day he took out two silver coins and gave them to the innkeeper with the instruction, 'Take care of him. If you spend more than what I have given you, I shall repay you on my way back. Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbor to the robbers' victim?' He answered, 'The one who treated him with mercy.' Jesus said to him, 'Go and do likewise.'" (Luke 10:29-37)

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME A Scriptural Reflection

Reflecting on God's Word

"Live and let live." "Mind your own business." "Leave well enough alone." "It's not your problem." "Don't get involved." So goes the wisdom of the world, the law of the jungle. One of these sayings may come to mind when you see a car accident, a bum on the sidewalk, a competitor going bankrupt, a parent slapping a child, a teenage prostitute, a news story about illegal immigrants being deported.

We who have received the love of Christ are to live by a different law. It is "very near to you . . . in your hearts; you have only to carry it out" (Deuteronomy 30:14). We are to live in Christ's love and let our neighbor experience that same life-giving love. And yet, like the "scholar of the law" in today's Gospel, we always try to define who is—or more precisely, who isn't—our neighbor. There's no escaping the message of this Gospel passage. Everyone we fear or despise, every victim, every outsider, every undeserving soul whom God loves, we are to "go and do likewise."

Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Nyeri is a women religious community that was founded in Kenya by Bishop Filippo Perlo and three founding members in 1918. In founding the congregation, Bishop Perlo, an Italian missionary, believed that anyone who would become part of the new community would walk in the footsteps of Jesus Christ in caring for the poor, the needy, and the suffering. Today, more than 400 sisters actively serve in teaching, healthcare, pastoral care, and a variety of social ministries in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Italy and the United States.

In Kiamumbi, one of Nairobi's outlying neighborhoods, children live in squalid slum conditions and are often orphaned, neglected and abused. For this reason, Maria Immaculata Children's Education Center serves as a beacon of hope. Founded in 1997 by the Sisters of Mary Immaculate, this combined home and school helps the area's neediest children grow into healthy, productive members of society. Its mission is to instill moral and spiritual values through care, encouragement, education and community intervention. Maria Immaculata Children's Education Center helps these deserving children realize their full potential and rise above the difficult socioeconomic circumstances from which they come.

STEWARDSHIP

Those People

Today's Gospel should trouble us more than it does. An expert in religious law wants Jesus to define "neighbor." In response, Jesus tells a disturbing story. A traveler is attacked and left for dead. A priest and Levite come upon him and walk around his body, afraid of impurity from the bloody "corpse." Along comes a Samaritan. Jews and Samaritans despised and avoided each other. The Samaritan sees that the beaten man is alive, cleans his wounds, and hauls him to the nearest inn, paying money to ensure his care. The priest, the Levite, and the Samaritan all saw the beaten man, but where the priest and the Levite saw a *problem*, the Samaritan saw a *person*. How quickly do we offer help to someone who might be trouble? Do we say silently, "If I give money they'll only spend it on alcohol or drugs," or "These people are always wanting handouts"? Jesus insists that "these people" are the neighbors we must love like ourselves. Let's get started.

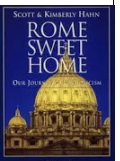

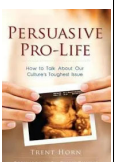

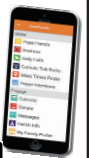
