SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME A Scriptural Reflection

Reflecting on God's Word

Our readings pair up the story of Jesus coming to dine at Martha and Mary's house with God coming to dine with Abraham and Sarah. And just as Abraham turned to Sarah for help in preparing the meal, Martha turns to her sister for a hand. After all, why should one person bear the burden of serving the Lord?

But Mary does not come into the kitchen, even after hearing her sister banging things around in there, perhaps a little more loudly than usual. Instead, she stays sitting at the foot of the Lord, listening to him. Martha, not one to keep her thoughts to herself, addresses directly the cause of her sister's prolonged delay: "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving?" (Luke 10:40).

As a matter of fact, Jesus didn't care. What he did care about was that Martha was all "anxious and worried about many things"(10:41). Jesus did not care about busy Martha but about worried and anxious Martha. Even more simply, what he cared about was Martha. Not the meal, not the table, not the time they ate, or whatever else was bothering her. He just cared about Martha — and Mary, too, of course. But he didn't have to worry as much about Mary.

Perhaps we could consider this simply a story about Jesus visiting two very dear friends and wanting some time with them both, together. And if that was true then, why wouldn't it be true now? If you find yourself worried and anxious these days, give yourself some time with the Lord.

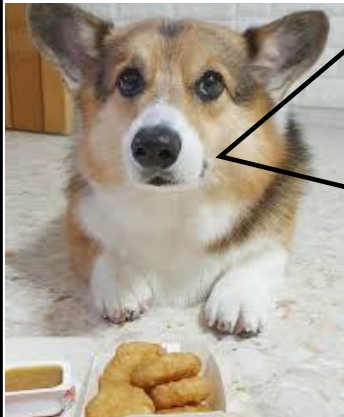

Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Nyeri is a women religious community that was founded in Kenya by Bishop Filippo Perlo and three founding members in 1918. In founding the congregation, Bishop Perlo, an Italian missionary, believed that anyone who would become part of the new community would walk in the footsteps of Jesus Christ in caring for the poor, the needy, and the suffering. Today, more than 400 sisters actively serve in teaching, healthcare, pastoral care, and a variety of social ministries in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Italy and the United States.

In Kiamumbi, one of Nairobi's outlying neighborhoods, children live in squalid slum conditions and are often orphaned, neglected and abused. For this reason, Maria Immaculata Children's Education Center serves as a beacon of hope. Founded in 1997 by the Sisters of Mary Immaculate, this combined home and school helps the area's neediest children grow into healthy, productive members of society. Its mission is to instill moral and spiritual values through care, encouragement, education and community intervention. Maria Immaculata Children's Education Center helps these deserving children realize their full potential and rise above the difficult socioeconomic circumstances from which they come.

STEWARDSHIP

Details, Details, Details...

Poor Martha. She complains to Jesus that her sister has left her with all the housework. Parents, caregivers, and restaurant workers, you know you can be run off your feet. Extra people makes more work. In Jesus' time it was unthinkable for a woman to sit as a disciple, so Martha is understandably irritated. "Martha," says Jesus gently, "you are anxious and worried about many things" (Luke 10:41). Mary's choice, to sit at Jesus' feet, shows that she sees how important it is to listen while Jesus is still with them. Martha knows who Jesus is (John 11:27), but forgets amid hostess duties. This is like what we do even now. We complain at Mass: the choir is too loud, the homily too long, altar servers are not reverent, people talk too much before Mass. When such details disrupt our attention we become Marthas. We are here to be Marys, focused on the Lord. Let's give him our complete attention and our profoundest thanks.

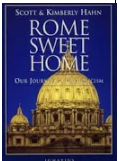

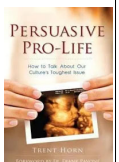
