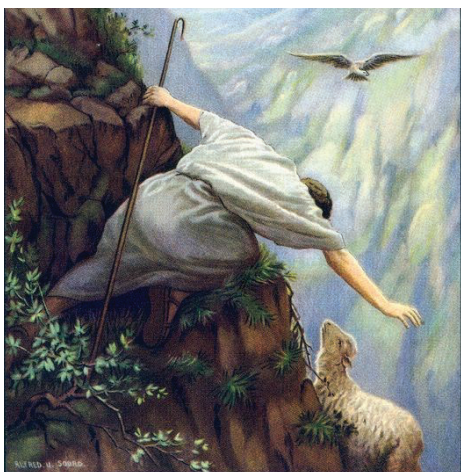


# Church of St. Mary Magdalene

## TWENTY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### A Scriptural Reflection

#### Reflecting on God's Word

Writing, it seems, is mostly about waiting, though most of us tend to think of it as a pen-in-hand sort of thing, or a fingers-on-the-keyboard activity. Eventually it does come to that, but much of the time before can be spent waiting. Some would say it's waiting for the muse to show, or imagination to kick in, or for the idea to float free.

Anyone who has ever tried to do some writing—a description of what it's like to fall in love or a piece of poetry or an attempt to share the meandering path of a soul's journey—knows that such writing takes a great deal of waiting before it can happen, if indeed it ever happens at all. And sometimes when it does happen, it feels more like being found than it does like succeeding.

Many of the inner pieces of our lives seem to be like that. Discovering one's calling, falling in love, faith and the conversion that gives rise to it, recognizing the gifts sewn into the hems and cuffs of our lives—they all seem to find us rather than the other way around. Sometimes it's even in spite of our own efforts. Sometimes they feel like the very work and intention of the Divine One.

The scriptures are filled with stories of God doing the finding, even when we didn't know we'd been lost. That's the way it is with us and God—so often being found without even asking.

### Relying On God's Love

Imagine being among those who heard Jesus address the Pharisees and scribes in the encounter we hear in today's Gospel: "What man among you having a hundred sheep and losing one of them would not leave the ninety-nine in the desert and go after the lost one until he finds it?" Would you leave ninety-nine in the desert in order to find one lost sheep? In the parable, Jesus is showing us the depths of God's love, the illogical, incredible love God has for each of us. Moses counted on this loving mercy as he spoke for the wandering people; Saint Paul acknowledges his reliance on it in his letter to Timothy. God desires to draw you close, seeking you when you are lost. Are you ready to be drawn into God's loving embrace?

## STEWARDSHIP

### The Forgiving Father

In Jesus' time, a first-born son inherited two-thirds of his father's property; younger sons got the rest. The younger son in today's Gospel cannot wait, demands his portion, and leaves. The money is quickly gone and he is reduced to herding pigs. He returns home, intending to confess his guilt and request to be a servant, not a son. Yet the father runs out to meet him, clothes him in finery, and orders a huge feast. The older son is hostile, although he is guaranteed his father's love and a fine inheritance. The father knows how to forgive and forget; sadly, the older son knows neither. Whatever the younger son *did* is nothing compared to who he *is* - the beloved child. This story invites us to consider whether we act like the younger son or the older son, or if we strive to act the way that God does toward us, as the forgiving father.
