 - iv) Sandy mentioned the usefulness of the states in the webinar/summarized on notes; will use in her course: family life with students at church school.
 - v) Gerry shares about the "Justice for the 5" campaign; In Washington D.C. a medical waste company discovers the remains of 5 aborted babies (full term). 66 congressmen are demanding an autopsy to determine if the babies were killed after birth.
