## THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

### A Scriptural Reflection

#### Reflecting on God's Word

My father used to refer to the town of my—and his—birth as a “nickel-and-dime” town. As a child, I was never exactly sure what he meant, but it didn't sound like a compliment. I think it was similar to Micah's words about Bethlehem as “too small to be among the clans of Judah” (5:1). Another description would be “backwater.” Hardly a place deserving of great expectations. Yet backwater Bethlehem, city of David the shepherd boy, was to be the birthplace of the Messiah—not Jerusalem, center of government and religion, city of David the warrior king.

God's strange choices extend beyond geographical sites to the people on whom God sets eyes. A young betrothed girl up in the north, a barren woman down in the south—these were chosen to play pivotal roles in the story of salvation. The once-barren Elizabeth, soon to bring forth the greatest of all prophets, now proclaims God's most marvelous work and the little one through whom God is working: “Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb” (Luke 1:42).

Elizabeth cues us to join in the response of the baby in her womb: to allow our hearts and spirits to leap for joy. Again and again God works through those who are open to the Spirit. Blessed are they who place their trust in the Lord, who continues to come to give us new life.

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

This week, as I assume you may have heard, Cardinal McElroy, Bishop of San Diego was transferred by Pope Francis to the Archdiocese of Washington D.C. He will begin his ministry in Washington after his installation in March. In the meantime he will continue to lead our diocese. In the next few months, a body of priests of the Diocese of San Diego called "the College of Consultors", will gather to select an administrator from our diocese to oversee the daily operations until Pope Francis appoints a new bishop for our Diocese. Let us pray for Cardinal McElroy as he prepares for his new appointment and let us pray to the Holy Spirit as we await the appointment of our new bishop.

I would ask you to keep in prayers this weekend the 28 students from our parish and St. Brigid parish as they are on retreat this weekend in final preparation to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation this Easter Season.

It is back and better than ever! I hope as many of you as possible will be able to join us for our Parish/School Pancake Breakfast on Sunday, January 26th following the 9:00am and 11:00am masses. This is a wonderful way for our parish and school communities to gather for fellowship and a wonderful breakfast. Remembering the great response we had last year please note tickets are being sold after the masses this weekend and next or see the flyer in today's bulletin for additional information.

Monday, January 22nd marks the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision *Roe vs. Wade*. In light of this tragic anniversary I would like to share with you a brief passage from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops Office for Pro-Life. "When we hear a phrase all our lives, it can become stale. No matter how true or profound, it loses the power to capture our attention and invite reflection. *Made in the image of God* is such a phrase. Because God created human beings in His own image, each of us has a unique dignity. "Of all visible creatures only man is 'able to know and love his creator'...and he alone is called to share by knowledge and love, in God's own life. It was for this end that he was created, and this is the fundamental reason for his dignity" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 356). *What does it mean to be made in the image of God?* Jesus himself is the answer. It means to be holy and loving, to give oneself for the sake of others even to the point of death, so we might share eternally in God's life, our souls united again with our risen bodies (*Catechism*, 459, 460). Even in this life our soul – which is our innermost self – is a single unity with our body (*Catechism*, 365). This oneness of body and soul calls us to treat our bodily life, and that of others, with the greatest respect. And the relationship God has established with and among us calls us to reach out to every human being with unconditional love.

Jesus taught that we must love one another as He loves us (*Jn. 15:12*). And the fact that every human is made in God's image has specific implications depending on one's situation in life."

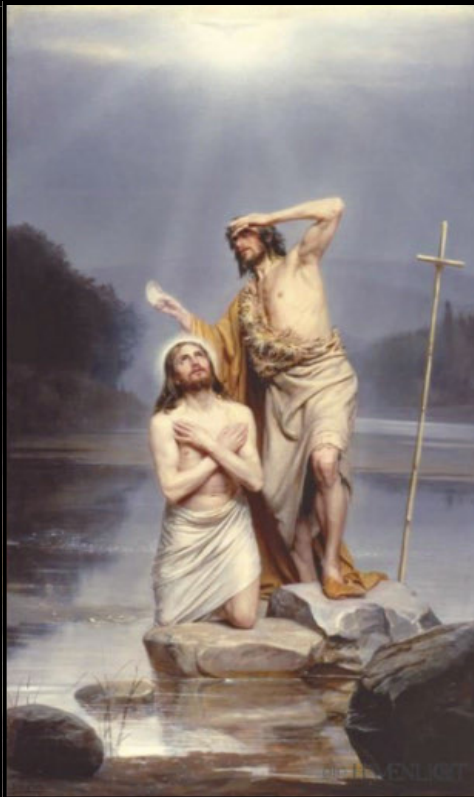
