## Welcome and Opening Prayer - Kristine

### Culture of Life Survey - Kristine

- Kristine reviewed the major categories of our recent Culture of Life Survey (please see attached report for the complete listing of results):
  - Pillar #1: Prolife/Abortion/Post Abortive Healing
    - High scored areas included
      - ◆ Continue with 40 days for Life, SD March for Life, Monthly Birthline Mass Table (6 votes)
      - ♦ Once a Quarter Speaker and Youth Ministry Baby Shower (each received 5 votes)
      - ♦ Women's Tea and Free Ultrasound Van Display (each received 1 vote)
  - Pillar #2: Culture of Life Education
    - High scored areas included:
      - ◆ Involve the school (bulletin inserts, COL craft contest) (4 votes)
      - ◆ Diocese Culture of Life Speaker, Family Friendly Movie Night, and Strategize on how to reach people based on demographics (each received 3 votes)
  - Pillar #3: Death Penalty and Restorative Justice
    - Only one category in the survey: Speakers on this topic (4 votes)

# Why We are Pro-Life booklet - ALL

- ➤ Diane mentioned that Ascension Press was offering free "Why We are Pro-Life" by Trent Horn booklets to Catholic organizations. Diane and Gerry were able to receive 150 booklets to be distributed at our monthly Culture of Life table.
- ➤ Kristine began a discussion of the booklet; key points of the discussion were:
  - Kristine strongly encouraged everyone to read the Introduction.
  - Working at the high school, Kristine has come to realize that moms/teenagers are very passionate
    of their pro-choice opinion and can be very angry.
  - Kristine stated that now she knows we all must start with a "note of compassion." And also, to start by asking questions to understand where they are. Kristine shared that many are coming from a place of "how can you force me to have a baby." Words matter and "forcing" is of course terrible. We must address their concerns with passion and see if they can see an alternative.
  - We discussed rape and how that word has changed meaning over time. Rape in the past may have meant an unknown unwelcomed attack. Now rape also includes date rape where there is drinking and unsureness of consent.
- ACTION: We discussed that we all read the booklet and at the December meeting, we will spend 10-15 minutes just recapping what we read.
- NOTE: 40 booklets are now stored with the Culture of Life materials for our table. Diane will replenish the supply each month. Please let her know if more than 40 booklets should be stored at the Church.
